### **TREASURERS REPORT**

### **GENERAL BUSINESS**

**We have left all 3 Notices of Motion in the minutes – please have a read through them. Obviously with all of them we are trying to end up at the same place – we just need to get the wording correct – any ideas please let Dave Roberts know – all advice will be taken on board.**

- Schools attending a representative school event have the ability to negotiate a different date and time to play the Grand Final if there is a clash. This must be a neutral agreement by both the schools involved. The convener of that particular sport, must be notified and where possible be in attendance. Any additional costs incurred will be payable by the school that has requested the change. The Blacktown PSSA President must also be informed. This game must be played within 7 days of the scheduled PSSA Grand Final game.

OR

- Blacktown PSSA has the authority to change the Grand Final date and or time for extenuating circumstances if a school cannot field a team on the designated date as long as it does not negatively effect the opposing team.

OR

- If either team, making the PSSA Grand Final in any sport, can show evidence to the Blacktown PSSA Executive, for extenuating circumstances as to why they cannot participate in the scheduled event, they are entitled to approach the opposition and seek a rescheduled date within seven days from the original scheduled date. Any rescheduling must be agreed upon by both teams and advised to the Blacktown PSSA Executive.

- Coaches afternoon will be held at our first PSSA meeting of the year this will commence at 4pm.
- A reminder to all conveners risk assessments for your sport must be emailed to every school before the commencement of the season.

- **Notice of motion**
- In the case of Football, Rugby League, League Tag, Netball, Handball and AFL, should a game be drawn at the end of regulation time, two additional periods of 5 minutes should be played. If the scores remain drawn at the conclusion of extra time, the two teams shall be recognised as Joint Premiers for that competition. In the case of Softball, T-Ball, if at the end of 40 mins the second innings has not been completed, that inning shall be completed. If 2 innings have been played by the 40 minute mark and the game is still a draw, a third innings shall be played. In the case of Cricket, if the scores are drawn at the conclusion of the game, then the two teams shall be recognised as Joint Premiers for that competition.
